

IASE News – August 2015

The IASE 2015 Satellite Conference at UNIRIO in Rio de Janeiro, "Advances in statistics education: developments, experiences, and assessments", had approximately 150 participants from 25 countries. For the first time at an IASE satellite, papers were presented in three languages - English, Portuguese, and Spanish; most sessions included papers in multiple languages. Thank you to Pedro Campos and the international program committee, Bruno Simoes and the local organizing committee, the student volunteers from UNIRIO, and many others who helped make a successful conference. For those interested in planning for future conferences, the following is a schedule of IASE-related events. Details about paper submission and registration will appear as they are released.

-- 19-22 July 2016: IASE Roundtable, a small workshop held every four years on a particular theme. The 2016 Roundtable will have the theme "Promoting the understanding of statistics about society" and will take place at the Max Planck Institute in Berlin, Germany.

-- 24-31 July 2016: ICME-13 in Hamburg, Germany. The International Congress on Mathematical Education has many topic study groups (TSG), including TSG 14 on probability and TSG 15 on statistics. Paper submissions are due on 1 October 2015.

-- July 2017: IASE Satellite around the 61st World Statistics Congress in Marrakesh, Morocco. The exact location and dates are not yet confirmed.

-- 9-13 July 2018: ICOTS 10, in Kyoto Japan.

-- July-August 2019: IASE Satellite around the 62nd World Statistics Congress in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The exact location and dates are not yet confirmed.
