

International Statistical Review: Call for Nominations for Co-Editor-in-Chief

The International Statistical Institute (ISI) invites nominations for Co-Editor-in-Chief of our flagship journal: [International Statistical Review \(ISR\)](#).

The journal has two Co-Editors-in-Chief: one covers (broadly speaking) theory and methodology and the second covers all the other areas. (This is not a strict separation, and there is overlap in responsibilities). The current search is to find a Co-EiC in theory and methodology to replace Marc Hallin. The other Co-EiC is Ray Chambers who was recently appointed.

The term of the new Co-EiC will start in January 2016. S/he must be a member of the ISI, a world-renowned leader in research, have a solid record of editorial experience, and be reliable as well as organized.

The nomination should include the name, contact information and some background on research as well as organizational and editorial experience of the nominee. Please also include a link to the web page. Self-nominations are not allowed.

The deadline for nominations is **May 30, 2015**.

Information on ISR:

The ISR is a journal of the ISI and all of its Associations. The ISR plays a unique role among statistical journals in that it publishes papers in all areas of statistics probability: theory and methodology, statistical computing, statistical education, official statistics, survey statistics, business and industrial statistics, environmetrics, statistics in the life sciences, history of statistics and applications, etc.

The term “review” is treated broadly to cover traditional review and survey papers as well as expository papers on emerging areas, challenges and new directions, papers dealing with public policy and societal issues, etc. The journal also publishes papers on new methodology of broad interest, but such papers have to include a substantive review component.

ISR is owned by ISI and is published by Wiley. There is an agreement between the two organizations to manage the editorial process, subscriptions, promotion, and revenue.

Starting this year, all ISI elected members receive free on-line access to ISR.
