### Registration Open for 2017 IASE Satellite Conference:

Registration is open for the 2017 IASE Satellite Conference, Teaching Statistics in a Data Rich World, to be held from 11 to 14 July in Rabat, Morocco. The programme includes keynote speakers Delia North from South Africa and Ali Rejali from Iran, five workshops, and approximately 50 contributed works by authors from all six populated continents (sorry, Antarctica.) After the satellite conference, many participants will travel by bus or train to the ISI meeting in Marrakesh, but this is not required and many people attend only the satellite.

Information on venue, travel, and accommodation has recently been added to the conference website <http://iase-web.org/conference/satellite17/> by the local organizing committee and the international program committee. Early registration closes on 30 April, and fees increase on 1 May, so there is an incentive to register soon. The committees hope to see many of you in Rabat in July.

### Prize Opportunity: ISLP Best Cooperative Project in Statistical Literacy:

The IASE supports the International Statistical Literacy Project (<http://iase-web.org/islp/>) The ISLP Best Cooperative Project prize is awarded every two years, in recognition of outstanding, innovative, and influential statistical literacy projects that affect a broad segment of the general public arising from cooperation between different types of institutions, such as, national statistical offices, schools, statistical societies, media, libraries, etc. The winning project receives 1000 Euros.

To qualify, projects should be current, make their resources freely available, have statistically sound content, and involve cooperation between at least two institutions that would not usually work closely together.
