New Book: Teaching and Learning Stochastics

Many IASE members participated in the 13th International Congress on Mathematical Education, which was held in Hamburg, Germany in 2016. Books of monographs inspired by conference presentations are being published by Springer. One book of interest, Teaching and Advancing Stochastics, has been recently published (with at least one more on statistics to follow). Editors Carmen Batanero and Egan Chernoff have collected about 20 papers from authors, from linguistics to case studies to experimental results.
