

Nominations are Open for the International Prize in Statistics



Nominations are open for the second edition of the [International Prize in Statistics](#), to be awarded at the [ISI World Statistics Congress 2019](#) in Kuala Lumpur.

The objective of the International Prize in Statistics is to call public attention to the important role statistics, data analysis, probability, and the understanding of uncertainty have played in the past and are playing today in the advancement of society, science, technology and human welfare, with a decided focus on current developments

The first International Prize in Statistics was awarded in July 2017 to David R. Cox.

The Prize was created by five international statistical societies: [American Statistical Association](#), [International Biometric Society](#), [International Statistical Institute](#), [Institute of Mathematical Statistics](#), [Royal Statistical Society](#).

Nominations are open through 15 August 2018. The 2019 International Prize in Statistics honoree will be announced in October 2018, and the prize will be presented at the ISI World Statistics Congress 2019 in Kuala Lumpur.
