

2018 Joint Statistical Meetings and ISI Participation

The Joint Statistical Meetings (JSM) are one of the largest statistical events in the world. Held each year, JSM attracts more than 6,000 attendees from 52 countries. This year's JSM will be held in Vancouver, Canada, from 29 July through 2 August.

The International Statistical Institute (ISI) is co-sponsoring 9 JSM sessions: four invited sessions, two topic contributed sessions, and three contributed sessions. In addition the ISI is co-sponsoring two poster sessions. The first invited session will be held on 29 July at 4:00 pm, with a panel discussion of real vs. fake news, including RSS President David Spiegelhalter.
