Post-Conference Report on ISBIS 2018: International Symposium on Business and Industrial Statistics

The ISBIS 2018 was successfully held at the Department of Statistics and Insurance Science, University of Piraeus, Greece, 4-6 July 2018. The scientific program concluded 42 sessions of approximately 120 excellent talks. Almost 150 people from 28 countries took part into the ISBIS 2018 Meeting.

The scientific program included 3 plenary speakers. At the first day, Prof. Evdokia Xekalaki presented a talk with title "On Modeling Overdispersion". At the second day, Prof. Ron Kenett presented a talk entitled "On information quality and customer surveys". At the third and final day of the Meeting, Prof. Subha Chakraborti presented a talk with title "(Almost) Two Decades of Statistical Process Control Research: Some Reflections".
