ISLP Best Cooperative Project Award 2019

We would like to remind everyone involved in improving statistical literacy that the ISLP best cooperative project award is still open until the end of April. Now is your chance to get some recognition for all your hard work. Tell us about it.

The Best Cooperative Project Award in Statistical Literacy is awarded every two years, in recognition of outstanding, innovative, and influential statistical literacy projects that affect a broad segment of the general public and are fruit of the cooperation of different types of institutions (national statistical offices, schools, statistical societies, media, libraries etc.)

Submitted projects should be, among other things, current, provide free access to the project resources, have pedagogically sound contents suitable for a general audience and involve at least two institutions that would not usually work closely together.
