### New President and Scientific Secretary of the Bernoulli Society

### New Bernoulli Society appointments from the General Assembly at ISI WSC

At the ISI World Statistics Congress 2019 in Kuala Lumpur, the Bernoulli Society General Assembly approved new office appointments:
