2019 Satellite Conference Summary

The 2019 IASE satellite conference in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia was very successful, with about 60 participants from 37 countries. Many thanks to the chair of the Local Organizing Committee, Zamalia Mahmud from Malaysia, and her colleagues from Universiti Teknologi MARA and Universiti Putra for organization. Additionally, thanks to the International Program Committee chaired by Laura Martignon for all of their work in making the conference a success. New IASE Executive Committee

The IASE Executive Committee changes every two years during the World Statistics Congress. The new 2019-21 committee will be led by Joachim Engel of Germany. Joachim is professor for mathematics and mathematics education at Ludwigsburg University of Education. From 2015-2018 he was coordinator of the EU funded strategic partnership ProCivicStat, focusing on statistical literacy and society.

The President-Elect is Ayse Bilgin of Macquarie University in Australia, who has published statistics education research on students in Australia, Turkey, and elsewhere. She served as chair of the International Program Committee for the 2017 IASE Satellite Conference. Ayse is scheduled to become President for 2021-23.

Five Vice-Presidents are chosen to ensure geographical representation. Thanks to Stephanie Budgett of New Zealand, Pedro Campos of Portugal, Rob Gould of the USA, James Kaleli Musyoka of Kenya, and Teresita Terán of Argentina, who will be Vice-Presidents for the next two years.
