

ISI Journal *Stat* - Call for Nominations for Editor-in-Chief

The International Statistical Institute (ISI) invites nominations for Editor-in-Chief of the journal [Stat](#).

Launched in 2012, *Stat* is an innovative electronic journal for the rapid publication of novel and topical research results. The journal publishes compact articles of the highest quality in all areas of statistical research. Its purpose is to provide a means of rapidly sharing important new theoretical, methodological and applied research. *Stat* is a joint venture between the ISI and Wiley-Blackwell.

Stat is characterized by:

- Speed – a single pass, high quality review process that aims to publish within 30 days of submission, but does not allow for revision and resubmission.
- Concision – a maximum article length of 10 pages of text, not including abstract, figures, tables, and references.
- Visuanimation: embed animations and movies in the article.
- Support: inclusion of electronic support materials including data, graphs, images, video and code.
- Scope: addresses all areas of statistics and interdisciplinary areas.
- Electronic delivery: delivery of articles and innovative forms of supplementary materials, using technology to allow readers to access and connect with content in novel ways.

The ISI is grateful to the current Editor-in-Chief Professor Marc Genton for his leadership and commitment to the ongoing success of *Stat*. Professor Genton will be stepping down at the end of 2017.

The new *Stat* Editor-in-Chief will serve from January 2018 to December 2020. S/he must be a member of the ISI and must be a world-renowned leader in research and also be knowledgeable in the use of information technology for electronic publication.

Nominations should be sent to Professor Xuming He, Chair of the ISI Publications Committee, xmhe@umich.edu. The nomination should include the name, contact information and a link to a CV which includes research and organizational background and editorial experience of the nominee.

The deadline for nominations is **31 July 2017**.
