

**ISI General Assembly
14:00 hours, August 2, 2014**

The ISI General Assembly (GA) was held during the ISI Council Meeting on August 2, 2014. Only the Council and Executive Committee members were present (since this was a non-WSC (World Statistics Congress) year).

The President welcomed everyone and mentioned that Dutch Law requires us to have a GA every year. He then presented a summary of the Annual Report for 2013. In particular, the following activities and accomplishments were highlighted: a) the WSC in Hong Kong in August 2013; b) ISI's contributions to the International Year of Statistics; c) ISI awards and the launching of the Karl Pearson Prize; and d) Statistical Capacity Building. The ISI finances and actions that are being undertaken to increase income and reduce costs were also described.

This was followed by brief presentations by Association Presidents/Representatives summarizing the activities of the Associations.

The Annual Report had been submitted to the ISI membership for a vote prior to the GA. All the votes received were positive except for one abstention. Based on this, the Annual Report was approved by the GA.

There were no new matters arising, and the meeting was adjourned at 14:40 hours.
