Dr. Sen is Research Associate Professor in the Departments of Family Medicine and Biostatistics at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, USA. He received his BS and MS in Statistics from Indian Statistical Institute in India and obtained a PhD in Statistics from University of Wisconsin at Madison in 1993. He has over one-hundred publications in peer-reviewed journals and invited book chapters. He has methodological expertise in the areas of competing risks, analysis of recurrent events data, and measuring inter-rater agreement. Dr. Sen also has extensive collaborative experience in cancer prevention and biomarker research with diet and disease endpoints. He is the principal investigator of the Biostatistics Core in the *Specialized Program on Research Excellence on GI cancer*, funded by the US National Cancer Institute. He serves on the editorial boards of *Communications in Statistics*, *Computational Statistics and Data Analysis*, and the *American Journal of Preventive Medicine*. He is currently a member of a panel on Reliability Growth Modeling, sponsored by the Committee on National Statistics in the US National Academy of Sciences. Outside his professional career, Dr. Sen nurtures a passion for stage acting. He also enjoys reading fiction, watching movies and traveling.
