



## **Election of ISI Officers Request for Nominations**

Nominations are being solicited from members of the ISI for the next slate of candidates for the ISI Executive Committee and Council. The positions to be filled and their terms of office are:

President-Elect (2015-17);  
Two Vice-Presidents (2015-19); and  
Eight Council Members (2015-19)

The ISI is currently engaged in a number of major initiatives, and the successful candidates will become involved in one or more of these efforts and also bring their own ideas to the leadership team. Some of these current efforts include: improving services and benefits to members, expanding the membership base among younger members and from developing countries, developing capacity building and monitoring activities, fund-raising to support key activities, and stimulating collaborations with other learned societies.

Please note that these are not honorary positions intended to reward individuals for their past accomplishments. Rather, the nominees should have the time, energy and dedication to become fully engaged in the ISI and to help lead it. They should have a reasonably broad knowledge of the field, the challenges it faces, and a vision of how to promote statistics at the international level. Please also consider diversity in terms of gender, geographical representation, and areas of interest as you make your nominations.
