


Monitoring Migration Indicators at Egypt in the Context of Sustainable Development

□Introduction

In September 2015, United Nations launched sustainable development goals (SDGs), Egypt was one of the 193 countries that adopted the SDGs and ratified the related agreements, the core of SDGs is a set of 17 Goals, 169 targets, and 232 indicators.

The Goals are presented as "integrated and indivisible, global in nature and universally applicable". The Agenda presents them as addressing the 5Ps: People (broadly corresponding to Goals 1-5), Planet (6, 12, 13, 14 and 15), Prosperity (7-11), Peace (16) and Partnership (17).

To meet the ambitions and demands of SDGs, the National Statistical office all over the world has started to review their statistical surveys and their systems, capabilities to monitor challenges and follow-up SDGs.

Efforts Exerted by NSO in Egypt to Monitor Migration


1- The Egyptian Household International Migration Survey (EGYPT – HIMS) with the support of International Organization for Migration (IOM)-2013.

- 2- Established sustainable development unit (SDU)-2016 and Egypt SDG Observatory& Mobil App.
- 3- Established Migration Data Analysis Unit (6 April 2017) and produced reports.
- 4-Participation at the IAEG-SDGs meetings.

Current situation for SDGs that related to Migration

17.3.2: Volume of remittances as a proportion of total GDP.

The value of remittances as a percentage of GDP in Egypt (2015/2016-2018/2019)

- Only one indicator(17.3.2) from 7 indicators of SDG,s that related with migration is available
- The volume of remittances in 25 billion dollars 2018/2019 reached to 25 billion dollars, at a rate of 8.1% of GDP.
- Egypt ranked sixth in the World Bank's classification of the countries most receiving remittances from abroad, with remittances reaching 24.38 billion dollars in 2020.
